Metaphysical Interpretation

Before we awaken to our spiritual identity, we are driven by our subconscious and physical senses. Our past memories, habits, and emotions dominate what we think, say and do. We may have an intellectual understanding of God as something above and separate from us. But we're unaware of the Christ Mind within and our spiritual abilities are barely used, only from our ego's perspective.

We must raise our thoughts to that Upper Room, the higher Super-Conscious Mind and focus our thoughts on God. We make way for the Holy Spirit to work in us by sweeping out limited beliefs from subconscious and illuminate our thoughts with words of Truth.
