

SERMON ON THE MOUNT



Matt 5:1-2

When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him.

Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying:

Matt 7:28

Now when Jesus had finished saying these things, the crowds were astounded at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority, and not as their scribes.

Metaphysical meaning of mountain (rw)

A mountain represents an exalted state of mind where the divine plan may be perceived and unfolded; a state of spiritual realization.

The "high mountain" to which personality carries us in our spiritual uplift is the consciousness of power over mortal thought in all its earthly avenues of expression.

Going up into the mountain to pray means elevating our thoughts and our aspirations to the spiritual viewpoint.
