



## -6-You shall not kill.

You shall not take your wealth out of circulation.






For to all those who have, more will be given, and they will have an abundance; but from those who have nothing, even what they have will be taken away.

Mt. 6.19-21





Exod. 20.14


You shall not abase your wealth to idle or evil uses.



## -7 Prosperity Commandment - You shall not abase your wealth to idle or evil uses.


**Abase** – Lower in rank / esteem **Adulterate** – To corrupt or make impure by addition of foreign or inferior substance.
